Spanish for the Global Professions and Translation

*The Concentration of **Spanish for the Global Professions and Translation** is designed for students who wish to continue the study of Spanish language and culture for specific professional purposes. The Concentration helps students to develop cross-cultural professional etiquette appropriate to different areas and contexts of the Spanish-speaking world in the U.S. or abroad. Students must complete a total of six credit units: two credits from 303, 304 or 306; one credit from 331 or 332; one credit 381; and two electives (see the list below).*
