For those registered voters for whom we could *not* verify that they voted in 2016, the margin was larger. About 2/3 of those respondents appear to have registered in Virginia since 2016, so they may have voted in another state in 2016. The other 1/3 were registered prior to 2016 and there is no record of them voting.
