



## **Senator Mark Warner's Spring Internship**

Senator Mark R. Warner's Roanoke office seeks undergraduates or recent graduates for a constituent services internship. Senator Warner serves Virginia in a variety of ways, including by developing public policy, providing direct assistance to individuals and local communities, and listening to the different needs of the diverse communities across the Commonwealth. He is proud to be able to offer students an opportunity to learn more about these responsibilities through an internship.

Preference will be given to candidates who have completed their first year of college and who reside in Virginia or attend college in-state. To be eligible for an internship, an individual must have graduated from high school. In order to be considered, all applicants must meet the requirements below, and submit an application by the deadline.

If applying for an internship in one of the Senator's Virginia offices:

Spring interns that meet the minimum time commitment and are authorized to work in the U.S., pursuant to federal law, will receive a stipend: \$1,000 pre-tax stipend for 12-23 hours per week commitments, or a \$2,000 pre-tax stipend for 24 hours or more per week commitments.

Duties might include: answering constituent phone calls and providing callers with assistance; processing constituent requests for assistance; helping staff develop regional outreach calendars; attending community outreach events; preparing congressional inquiries; supporting the congratulatory letter operation; front office duties; basic office administration; and performing a host of other tasks, large and small, that help the Senator achieve his Constitutional obligations.

In order to be considered, interested applicants must complete the online application located on Senator Warner's website by 10am on Monday, December 2nd: https://www.warner.senate.gov/public/index.cfm/internships.

As a Public Health Intern at the Bradley Free Clinic, you will work with the Executive Director and Health Administrator. You will learn about all aspects of what it takes to run a non-profit healthcare facility, including learning about board and governance, financials (where does the funding come from for a FREE Clinic?), and clinic staffing. You will also learn about clinical department functions and what it takes to keep things moving, from patient flow to necessary supplies and volunteer providers. You will also learn about Electronic Healthcare Records systems, HIPPA guidelines, general triage, and check-in for patients.

The most important experience you will receive is the day to day contact with our patients at the Free Clinic, the low—income, underserved population in our community who so desperately need the Free Clinic for medical, dental, behavioral health, and pharmacy services. The Free Clinic is the safety net in the community to help those who fall between the cracks and those who don't qualify for government subsidies yet still can't afford the high costs of healthcare.

This is an unpaid opportunity that will require about 10 hours per week during the spring semester.
